
26.Fuel Filter

A: REMOVAL

WARNING:

- Place "NO FIRE" signs near the working area.
- Be careful not to spill fuel on the floor.

 Release the fuel pressure. <Ref. to FU(H4SO)-49, RELEASING OF FUEL PRESSURE, Fuel.>
Disconnect the fuel delivery hoses from the fuel filter.



3) Remove the filter from the holder.

B: INSTALLATION


CAUTION:

• Replace the fuel hose with a new one if the connecting portion of fuel hose is damaged.

- Replace the clamp with a new one if the clamp is damaged seriously.
- 1) Install in the reverse order of removal.
- 2) Tighten the hose clamp screws.

Tightening torque:

1.25 N·m (0.13 kgf-m, 0.94 ft-lb)



C: INSPECTION

1) Check the inside of fuel filter for dirt and water sediment.

2) If it is clogged, or if the replacement interval has been reached, replace it.

3) If the water is found in it, shake and expel the water from the inlet port.
